

# Downloading eBooks onto a Wireless- Enabled Nook



## Introduction:

The Westfield Memorial Library provides eBooks to library patrons through three independent vendors: Freading, eLibrarynj, and EBSCO eBooks. eLibrarynj runs on software called "Overdrive."

To set up your Nook you have to register with Adobe (Adobe protects copyrights) and download the relevant apps. After these steps are completed you can search our regular online catalog for eBooks. Our catalog is integrated with all three eBook vendors, so you do not have to search on their individual websites.

These instructions assume you have Wireless capability on your Nook.

## Getting your Nook Set Up

First, authorize your Nook by registering with Adobe.

1. Google "Get an Adobe ID" or go to <https://www.adobe.com/account/sign-in.adobedotcom.html>
2. Click on "Not a member yet? Get an Adobe ID."
3. Fill in the requested information.

Now get the necessary apps.

1. Go to the Nook Store.
2. Download the Overdrive Media Console (for eLibrarynj),
3. Go the Google Play Store.
4. Download Freading and BlueFire Reading (for EBSCO eBooks) apps.

## Finding and Downloading eBooks

1. Go to the Westfield Library's homepage, [www.wmlnj.org](http://www.wmlnj.org), and search for a book on the online catalog. You can search by title, author, or subject.
2. You can filter the results for eBooks only by clicking on the link in the left column of the page.
3. When you find a title you want, click on the title.

If the URL says “A book accessible through the internet; click for information” please follow the **eLibrarynj** instructions.

If the URL starts with <http://wmlnj.freading.com> please follow the **Freading** instructions.

If the URL starts with <http://search.ebscohost.com> please follow the **EBSCO ebook** instructions.

4. Whatever vendor the book is from, click on the URL.

## Instructions for Different eBook Vendors

### For eLibrary NJ

- a. Click on “Sign in for availability.”
- b. Choice “Westfield Memorial Library” and then enter your barcode.
  - ▶. If you see “Place a Hold” it means that no copy is available. Please put the book on hold.
- c. If you see “Borrow” click “Borrow.”
  - ▶. You can read an ebook in your browser, but this means the ebook is not kept on your iPad.
- d. Choose Adobe epub or pdf.
- e. Open the file.
- f. “Confirm and Download.”

### For Freading

- a. Log in, enter your library barcode when prompted.
- b. Download epub.
- c. Open the file. It will open in the Freading app.

### For EBSCO eBooks

- a. You must have an account to download EBSCO eBooks, so click on “Sign In.”
- b. Click on “Create a chargeback account” and fill in the information.
- c. Click “Download (Offline)”
  - ▶ If you don’t want to store the ebook on your device, you can choose “eBook Full Text” and read online. If you read online the ebook will not be available if you lose your internet connection.
- d. If you are downloading the ebook choose a checkout period and then click “Checkout and download.”
- e. Open the ebook in the BlueFire app.
